**First All India Online Olympiad on Russian Language**

The purpose of organizing this Olympiad is to popularize Russian Language and Culture in India and to promote dialogue between the cultures of India and Russia.

**Who can participate?**

- School students, Undergraduates studying Russian at Indian Universities
- Post graduates, Scholars studying Russian at Indian Universities
- University and School teachers of Russian Language in India.

**The Online Olympiad will be held in TWO Stages:**

First stage (**Qualifying Round**) from **05.10.2020 to 12.10.2020**

Second stage (**Final Round**) from **15.11.2020 to 20.11.2020**

For the **Qualifying round**, the participants will have to appear for online Test comprising multiple-choice questions to assess proficiency in Russian Language, Literature, Culture and History in accordance with the following levels:

- For School students, Undergraduates studying Russian at Indian Universities the Test will be in accordance with the **Level A2**.
- For Post graduates, Scholars studying Russian at Indian Universities the Test will be in accordance with the **Level B2**.
- For University and School teachers of Russian Language in India the Test will be in accordance with the **Level C1**.

The Test will be conducted on the Pushkin Institute's Portal "Education in Russian". <https://pushkininstitute.ru/>.

**Registration: from 15.09.2020 till 30.09.2020** on the website <https://pushkininstitute.ru/>.

For the **Final Round**, the selected participants will be asked to record a short video clip.

School students, Undergraduates will be required to make a video clip on one of the proposed topics demonstrating their fluency in Russian in accordance with the level A2. The link of the video must be shared/posted on the Pushkin Institute's Portal "Education in Russian".

Post graduates and Scholars will be required to make a video clip on one of the proposed topics demonstrating their fluency in Russian in accordance with the level B2. The link of the video must be shared/posted on the Pushkin Institute's Portal "Education in Russian".

Teachers will be required to make a video clip on one of the proposed topics on Methodology. The link of the video must be shared/posted on the Pushkin Institute's Portal "Education in Russian".

## **Award for the Winners of the Online Olympiad**

**All the participants of the Online Olympiad will be given E-Certificates.**

The Winner of Level A2 and the Winner of Level B2 will get an Award Certificate along with an invitation to study Russian Language in 2021 (offline at the Pushkin Institute or online, as decided by the organizers)

All the participants of the Final round of Level C1 will get E-Certificates. All the Finalists of Level C1 will be invited to attend the online Faculty Development Programme and will be awarded a certificate of advance training.

An Online Conference will be held between 16.12.2020 to 20.12.2020.
